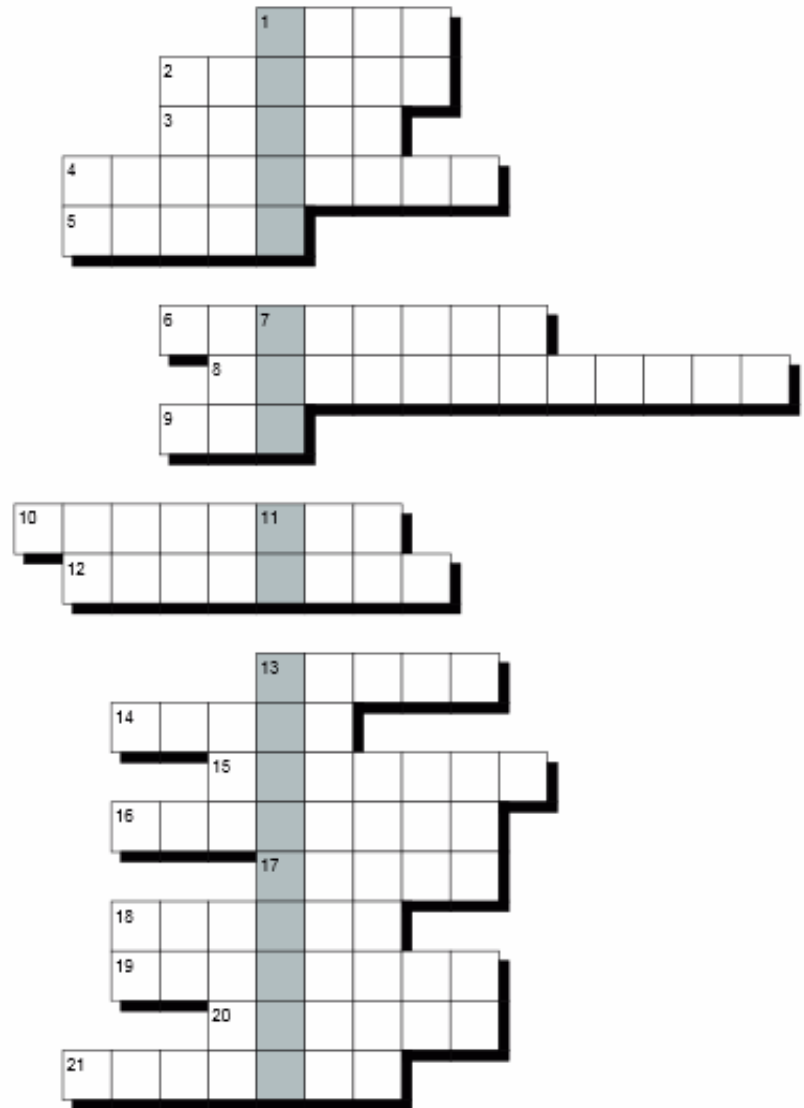
HEZEKIAH - JUDAH'S GREATEST KING

¹⁷For *there* were many in the congregation that were not sanctified: therefore the Levites had the charge of the killing of the passovers for **(3 Across)** one *that* was not clean, to sanctify *them* unto the LORD. ¹⁸For a multitude of the people, *even* many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The **(1 Across)** LORD **(2 Across)** every one ¹⁹*That* **(4 Across)** his **(5 Across)** to seek God, the LORD God of his fathers, though *he* be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary. ²⁰And the LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people.

²¹And the children of Israel that were present at Jerusalem kept the feast of unleavened bread **(17 Across)** days with great **(12 Across)**: and the Levites and the priests praised the LORD **(9 Across)** by day, *singing* with loud instruments unto the LORD. ²²And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the LORD: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, **(10 Across)** peace offerings, and making confession to the LORD God of their fathers. ²³And the whole assembly took counsel to keep other seven days: and they kept *other* seven days with **(12 Across)**. ²⁴For Hezekiah king of **(7 Across)** did give to the congregation a **(16 Across)** bullocks and seven thousand sheep; and the princes gave to the congregation a thousand bullocks and ten thousand **(14 Across)**: and a great number of **(15 Across)** sanctified themselves. ²⁵And all the **(8 Across)** of **(13 Across)**, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of **(18 Across)**, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in **(13 Across)** **(6 Across)**. ²⁶So there was great joy in Jerusalem: for since the time of **(21 Across)** the son of David king of **(18 Across)** *there* was not the like in Jerusalem. ²⁷Then the priests the Levites arose and blessed the people: and their voice was heard, and their prayer came *up* to his holy **(19 Across)** place, *even* unto **(20 Across)**.
